

DIASPORA: OPPRESSED BY FUNDAMENTALISM & TRANSNATIONAL HARASSMENT



Diaspora Exodus

Around 500,000 Uyghurs live in diaspora, subject to statelessness, family separation, unhealed trauma, ongoing fear.

They may be “safe,” but they are increasingly subjugated by an oppressive religious fundamentalism, or worse, radicalization.

Meditate, Pray: (15 min) Perseverance until Deliverance

Prayers for Perseverance

- By faith [Moses] left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw Him who is invisible. Heb 11:27
- All these people [forefathers] were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised...[i]nstead, they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore God...has prepared a city for them. Heb 11:13
- ...[W]e know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. Rom 5:3-5

Prayers for Deliverance

- Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy. Prov 31:8-9
- You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. Ps 32:7
- The LORD looked and was displeased that there was no justice. He...was appalled that there was no one to intervene...Is 59:15-16
- My righteousness draws near speedily, my salvation is on the way, and my arm will bring justice to the nations. The islands will look to me and wait in hope for my arm. Is 51:5

Prayers of Lament/Adoration (5 min)

Lament

- Though “free,” diaspora continue to suffer statelessness, trauma, survivor guilt, and transnational oppression
- There are few reliable channels for asylum – the world largely chooses to align with economic interests
- Justice seems far away
- “LORD, you are the God who saves me; day and night I cry out to you. May my prayer come before you; turn your ear to my cry.” Ps 88:1-2

Adore

- Wherever Uyghurs go, God is there!
- Diaspora believers are often deeply rooted – refined by suffering
- Diaspora are usually more accessible to believers and workers
- The diaspora is freer to access materials, in print and online
- New social media mechanisms offer Jesus-ways of thinking about existential questions

Prayers for Perseverance (12 min)

- Declare: God loves Uyghurs; remember multitudes gathered around the throne
- Courage: Grace and wisdom for cultural adjustment
- Comfort: For sustainment during times of economic hardship, especially for single mothers
- Home: For the uprooted to persist until Jesus can offer them a heart home
- Connection: Unrooted Uyghurs would find family even when separated
- Hope: Ask Holy Spirit to open hearts and minds to the Jesus way



Prayers for Deliverance (12 min)

- Declare God's love over Uyghurs
- End existential uncertainty – provide efficient and unobstructed pathways for residency and jobs
- Heal survivors from trauma
- End transnational oppression; prompt countries to resist
- End statelessness – ask God for systemic pathways to citizenship in safe havens
- End cultural oppression from religious orthodoxy and the false promise of radical revenge



Prayers of Adoration, Praise (5 min)

- Justice is His name:
“And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?” Luk 18:6
- Celebrate! The glorious end of God’s story is already written:
“After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb...” Rev 7:9
